This informational guide should help with making correct class entries for the Fair shows.
Follow Current #179 4-H Rule Book for Tack and Attire

All Classes:

1 Horse / 1 Rider / 1 Number Combination
2nd and 3rd Horse/Pony, Mini/Sm Equine Projects Keep Individual Tally
No Combined Scores For Awards or High Points

Class Divisions – Based on age on January 1 of current year

Seniors 14-18 year olds

Juniors 8-13 year olds

Walk/Trot – 8-18 year olds (Prohibited ~ Entry Into ANY Canter Class)

Open – 8-18 year olds

LCF Buddy and Lead Line Classes - 5-7 year olds – Sibling of 4-H'er Youth Members in Same Club ONLY

Showmanship Classes

All Participants must enter at least 1 class to complete their project

Western Showmanship – May Enter Only 1 Class per Horse/Rider/Number Combination

English Showmanship – May Enter Only 1 Class per Horse/Rider/Number Combination

Note: Walk/Trot Showmanship Classes may be included in Championship Class, Cheri Siravo and Showmanship Sweepstakes Championship Classes.

Horsemanship/Equitation Classes

All Participants are encouraged to participate in at least 1 class.

Gymkhana/Contesting Participants must enter at least 1 class to be eligible to participate in gymkhana/contesting classes.

Western Horsemanship – May Enter Only 1 Class per Horse/Rider/Number Combination

English Equitation – May Enter Only 1 Class per Horse/Rider/Number Combination

Mini Combo & Versatility Classes - Specialty Classes

Sign-ups for ONLY these 2 classes are at the Fair after the Showmanship Classes.

May Enter up to 3 classes of the same height

Western Riding and Western Reining Classes

Western Riding - May Enter Only 1 Class per Horse/Rider/Number Combination

Western Reining – May Enter Only 1 Class per Horse/Rider/Number Combination

Gymkhana/Contesting Classes

May Enter Any or All Classes according to age division and open classes

Walk/Trot Classes - Entries May Not Enter Any Canter Classes Throughout the Fair Week

All Youth may Enter according to age division

Costume Class

Must present a story paragraph about their costume and representation to be read during class
Must turn in a typed story paragraph by **10am On Wednesday** of fair week – to be eligible to enter class

Easy-Gaited Dressage – I J A – Western or Saddle Seat

Sign-Up Class Number and Test Letter/Number on Entry Form
Choose 2 Classes in the Same Level Only for All Easy-Gaited Dressage Classes

Ranch Riding Classes

Participating in Ranch Showmanship requires Participation in Ranch Riding Classes
May Enter both Ranch Riding and Ranch Pleasure
Consult Current #179 4-H Rule Book for Class Requirements, Patterns, Tack and Attire

Trail Classes

May Enter Trail In-Hand and Ridden Trail, since they are on two different days show schedule
Consult Current #179 4-H Rule Book for Class Requirements, Tack and Attire

LCF Buddy and LCF Buddy Lead Line Classes

Designed for younger family youth (5-7) to participate in.
The LCF Buddy must be a sibling of a 4-H member within the club and use the same horse/horses as the older youth member. No Cross-Club Entries.
LCF Buddies are prohibited to bring x-tra horses/ponies/sm equine into Fair or use another member's animal.
A "Share Equine Application" must be completed and returned to SHAC by the designated deadline.
LCF Buddy and LCF Buddy Lead Line may enter only classes designated by **LCF** prefix. All Entries must be completed and returned by the same date as all Lucas County Fair Registration Deadline.
All 4-H Attire, Equipment, Rules and Regulations will be adhered to governing classes. **Helmets Required**
LCF Buddy Classes not eligible for Championship Classes.

Contesting Showmanship and Contesting Horsemanship Classes are Mandatory for Contesting Horse & Pony Projects if they do not enter any other Regular Showmanship or Horsemanship / Equitation Classes, excluding PAS and Special Event Classes. For Gymkhana/Contesting Horsemanship Class - Contesting Equipment is allowed. Tie-downs and Hackamores are acceptable. Splint Boots, Bell Boots and Chaps are not allowed. Approved SEI/ASTM helmets are required.

Safety Helmets Are Required for all riding, jumping and driving classes both in and out of the show arena and whenever riding or driving a horse or pony on the fairgrounds during any practice time or 4-H event. ~ Adopted 2009

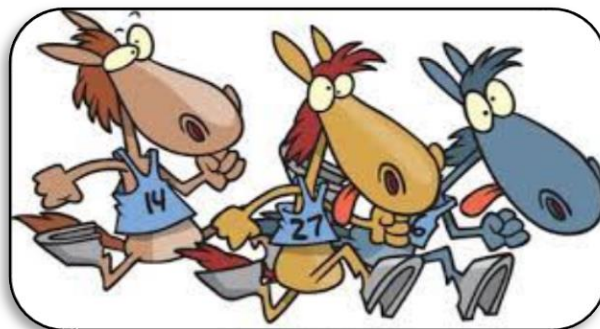

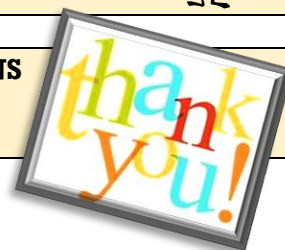
