LUCAS COUNTY SHAC ~ SIBLING HORSE SHARE RULES

This policy is provided for hardship and safety purposes only. Two 4-H members (siblings only) may share one (1) horse as a saddle horse exhibit/entry at the Lucas County Fair. The following guidelines and restrictions established in this policy on horse sharing must be followed. The siblings must fill out an application to share the horse project and submit it to SHAC prior to entry deadline.

1. For the family which owns *more than one* horse, this application *cannot* be filed for the specific use of a performance class only.

2. Only <u>one</u> sibling may <u>participate</u> in <u>PAS</u> and try to qualify for State with a shared horse project. This individual should be designated as the **primary rider** on the completed application and returned for consideration

3. Class participation must also be designated at time of application.

4. *Each* child *must* declare their *division* on application.

Declaration of *Championship Class Participation Must* also be <u>designated/declared</u> at time of application.

5. <u>30 days Rule</u> - Application Must Filed with SHAC by the <u>April SHAC Meeting</u>. Completed application must be submitted prior to the Lucas Co Fair projected registration deadline in May of current year, for their consideration. Application approval/denial will be made within 14 days from receipt and all parties notified.

6. A *Shared Horse* is a *4-H project* for <u>both</u> individuals, and **both** individuals **must complete** <u>all</u> **requirements** as set by SHAC and/or the State 4-H Equine Rules and Guidelines. This includes, but not limited to: Skillathon participation, book completion/testing, a showmanship class, Quality Assurance participation, and any individual SHAC, county, or club requirements.

7. Shared horse cannot enter the same *"pattern required"* and *"age division"* class twice. (Examples: reining, western riding, trail, pattern, dressage, contesting, and combo/versatility, etc). Horse *must not enter* the same class and age division twice

8. **4-H Equine Production Projects** cannot be shared. (*ie:* mares & foals, weanlings, yearlings, 2yr olds)
